Components:

SMALL TEAM COMPETITIVE BIRDWATCHING

Break into groups of 2 or 3 and set out across 72 acres of mixed use grounds and trails to track 5 common and 5 not-so-common birds. Team with most sightings wins a prize!

HANDS ON LEARNING (Either Residential Composting Or Agroforestry)

Come back together in our outdoor Learning Lab for a hands on session with Farm/Land Coordinator, Grail member and permaculture expert, Mary Lu Lageman to learn about residential composting or agroforestry

MEDITATION LABYRINTH

Move to the Oratory—an 1812 cattle barn converted in 1961 by local liturgical artist William Schickel into the spiritual home of The Grail—to learn basic meditation via the indoor labyrinth (Chartres Cathedral design)

Afterwards, you are welcome to bring in food for a shared meal either picnic style or in our meeting space in the Oratory.
